Alfredo Bernal, 94 years old of Spring, Texas passed away on Thursday, April 11, 2024 peacefully, with his son, Al Bernal, Jr. and his wife, Kimberly by his side. His son played his favorite song and sang it to him in his final moments. Alfredo was just a few months away from his 95th birthday.
