



## Bobby J Meigs

June 10, 1934 - April 6, 2019

Mr. Meigs went to be with his Lord and Savior on Saturday, April 6, 2019 after a lengthy illness. He was surrounded at home by his loving family and will always be remembered for his strong faith in the Lord and his gentle, calm spirit. His confidence and dedication to share his wisdom and knowledge impacted those of all walks of life. He was preceded in death by his parents, Hilton and LaValerie Meigs.

Bobby was born on June 10, 1934 in Pineland, TX and was raised in Beaumont, TX. He graduated from French High School and later relocated to Tyler, TX with his family. He joined the United States Army in 1954 and was stationed in Germany as a medic for two years serving in the Korean War. After his discharge, he received his Bachelor of Business Administration from Stephen F Austin State University and Master of Education at Lamar University. Mr. Meigs was also certified as a Licensed Professional Counselor. He worked for the Internal Revenue Service for several years before entering into the educational field. He taught in multiple public school systems before becoming a high school counselor. Bobby retired from teaching and counseling after 32 years. He married the love of his life, Janie Meigs, in 1958 at Omen Road Church of Christ in Tyler. Later, he served as a deacon and elder at Silsbee Church of Christ. At the time of death, he was a faithful member of Bammel Church of Christ.

Mr. Meigs is survived by his wife of almost 61 years; his son, Jody Meigs and wife Francisca of Houston; daughter, Jill Meigs of Houston; sister, Bonnie

Broussard of China, TX; brothers Douglas Meigs and wife, Vergie, and Timothy Meigs and wife, Connie all of Houston; granddaughter, Leslie Meigs of Houston; grandson, Andrew Meigs of Houston, currently residing in Costa Rica; and many special nieces, nephews and cousins who loved him dearly.
