Bonnie Martinson was born on October 20, 1955 in Livingston, Montana to Ferdinand and Blanche Lange. She grew up in the bitter cold with her two sisters and widowed mother. Her father passed away at her tender age of five. Her mother was dedicated to the Gospel of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints standards. At Brigham Young University, she met her future husband, but her education was so important that she denied Niel's proposal until after graduation. She graduated Valedictorian in Nursing and they married the next day. Her first pregnancy of twins was bittersweet, as her first born was a full term stillborn, whom she is with now. Through 20 years of being an ER nurse, she also had more boys! When the youngest started school, she went back to the University of Texas and obtained her Master's Degree. She chose her husband and her seven boys over a lifelong dream of becoming a doctor. A Nurse Practitioner and a wonderful caretaker was the next best thing. Out of nowhere, she was hit with Stage 3 Breast Cancer. She fought the battle hard and in defiance even rode her bicycle all the way to her last chemo treatment. She was in remission for 18 years and continued to help and heal others while practicing medicine. Her full life was always focused on taking care of others. After 40 years of nursing, the cancer returned but even worse as it progressed into Stage 4 Bone Cancer. She passed away in paradise while doing what she loved to do, traveling with her husband.
