



Carmelo Serafin de Guzman

July 25, 1959 - September 21, 2022

Carmelo de Guzman, beloved husband, father, son, and brother, died on September 21, 2022. He was born in the Philippines and emigrated to the United States, spending time in Hawaii, and Illinois before moving to Texas. He earned a bachelor's degree in Graphic Design from the University of Illinois. He spent more than twenty years working at ConocoPhillips in various roles in the Communications Department.

Carmelo spent his life in service to his family. He valued the company of his father and spent many happy hours playing poker with him and the rest of the Poker Gang. He always looked forward to his brothers' visits, which often included movie showings.

His wife, Allison, was greeted with a cup of tea every morning and often found that her nearly empty gas tank was refilled as if by magic. Carmelo was also a devoted father. From the time of his children's' births, he made it his mission to ensure they felt loved and valued. Carmelo did more than his share of nighttime feedings and stopped everything when one of his children requested his attention. He played every board game, cut the crusts off of thousands of sandwiches, and read certain storybooks until Carmelo memorized them.

He is survived by his wife Allison, their children Josh and Claire, his brothers Rico and Jimmy, and many in-laws, aunts and uncles, cousins, and friends.

He is preceded in death by his father Raul and his mother Alicia.
