Carolyn Ann Fields Banasik, 69, went into God's Hands on July 25, 2015 after a long illness. Carolyn was born in South Charleston, West Virginia in 1945. She graduated from Washington District High School in 1963 as Cum Laude, attended Morris Harvey Collage and West Virginia Institute of Technology near her birth town. After marriage, Carolyn and her family lived in Richmond, VA, Parkersburg, WV, Austin, TX, Houston, TX, Missouri City, TX, and Spring, TX. While raising her young family, Carolyn returned to college and graduated in 1983 from The University of Houston Central Campus with a Bachelor of Science in Psychology, and as a member of the Golden Key National Honor Society. She continued her higher education at The University of Houston Clear Lake graduating in 1986 with a Masters of Arts in Clinical Psychology, and as a member of The National Honor Society in Psychology. In 1990, Carolyn became a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) in Texas and practiced in the Houston area.

Raised Baptist, Carolyn converted to Catholicism in 1966. She was married in St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Parkersburg, WV in August of that same year. In recent years, Carolyn was a member of the Holy Family Catholic Church in Missouri City, TX, St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in Houston, TX, and St. Edwards Catholic Church in Spring, TX. Carolyn was proceeded in death by her father, Darrell Fields, her mother Lola Fields, and her brother Jarrell Fields. She is survived in death by her brother Dana Fields, her sister Deloris Bush, her husband Jerome "Jerry" Banasik, her sons Jerome Banasik,
