Charles Wayne Collins, 76, passed away on July 2, 2024. Charles was born on September 10, 1947, in Pasadena, Texas to Otho and Lucy Collins. He graduated from Reagan High School in Houston, Texas. After high school, Charlie worked in construction doing concrete work, mostly building tilt-walled buildings. After about 24 years, he went to work for Klein ISD in maintenance, where he stayed for 21 years until his retirement. In his early years, he loved fishing, hunting, and camping; later in life he developed a passion for owning and restoring his 55' Chevy. In the last five years he had become active in local car shows and had won awards for his car. Charlie was a member of many car groups; Houston Classic Car Club, Lone Star Street Rod Assn., and Goodguys Rod and Custom Assn. Charlie always wanted his lawn to look neat and trimmed so he mowed every Friday with his John Deere tractor; he mowed so often that he went through four tractors! His most recent was a John Deere zero turn that he used to mulch leaves every day. Several times a week he would take his scooter up to the local mechanic shop to visit with the mechanics and anyone else who happened to be in the shop. He would start conversations with anyone he met. While Charlie didn't travel much, he did take a cruise to Alaska and a bus tour in Memphis and Nashville, TN; he also always looked forward to the annual Thanksgiving trip to Oklahoma. In his spare time, Charlie enjoyed watching TV with his dog, Osco, asleep in his lap. He would watch the birds and squirrels on the feeders in the yard for hours.

Charlie is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Sharon Lynn Williams Collins; his sister, Linda Fridye; and his brother, Bill Collins; along with many nieces and nephews and their families.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Otho and Lucy Collins; his sisters, Inez Lenox, Laverne Reed, and Otha Mae Collins; and his brother, Lawrence Y. Collins II.
