Charles John Flynn Jr. (Charlie), 82, from Spring, TX passed away the morning of April 17, 2025 in Houston, Texas after a long and hard fought battle with leukemia. He was born June 13, 1942 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and was the beloved son of Charles and Vera Flynn.

Charlie grew up in a very large Irish Catholic family, the oldest of twelve siblings in Chester, Pennsylvania. He attended school at St. James Catholic School and then joined the United States Navy at age 17. He was a very proud veteran. He had many fond memories of his days serving our country that he always loved to share. He moved his family to Houston, Texas in 1976 where he raised his family and started his HVAC business Flynn Service Company. Those who knew Charlie will remember him for his fun, easy going nature.
