Charles Edwin Lechliden, born December 1, 1939, to Loyce and Charles Lechliden in Vinita, Oklahoma. Charles attended Central High School where he met Linda Kay Longacre. They married on August 27, 1958, shortly before Charles left to serve in the Army during the Korean War as a cartographer in Germany. Ronald Dean was born January 10, 1960, in Lawton, Oklahoma while Charles was still serving in the Army. Kevin Todd was born October 4, 1962, in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Charles arrived in Houston to work for May Aluminum in El Campo as a project manager detailer for the construction of the Astrodome. The rest of the family arrived in Houston, TX in 1963 via railroad into Union Station. He then went to work for Binswanger Glass and Hendrix Glass and Mirror before opening his own company, Omega Glass, in 1971. He returned to Hendrix Glass and Mirror in 1978. He continued to work in the glass business as an executive for many more years at various firms. He was instrumental in the construction of many of the buildings in Downtown Houston and the Galleria Area. He was further instrumental in the construction of Shriners Burn Center in Galveston, Texas. Charles was a 50 plus year member of the Freemasons and The Shriners organizations. Charles also donated his time to The Gideons International Association and was an active member of Faithbridge Church in Spring, TX.

Charles was preceded in death by his loving wife of 63 years, Linda in June 2021.

Charles is survived by their sons, Ronald Dean and his wife Ellen and Kevin Todd and his wife Bobbie, and his brothers Larry of Tulsa, OK and Jimmie of Tulsa, OK, along with numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, great-great grandchildren and nieces and nephews.
