Christopher Francis Trapani, Sr. passed away on the evening of November 3rd after a difficult fight with cancer. He was surrounded by loved ones in his home the way he wanted.

Chris was born in Brooklyn, New York on October 17th, 1947. From an early age it was apparent that he was gifted musically, playing keyboard instruments and the trumpet. He was a lyricist, composer, band member, and vocalist. He graduated from City University of New York – Staten Island with a degree in marketing and business management.

He had a career in sales, working in marketing and product development for various men's footwear companies. Chris began his career in the footwear industry selling shoes while working his way through school. While working he met his wife, Delores. In 1990 he was recruited for a job, moving his family to the Houston area. Later in life he worked in sales at Volvo where he enjoyed being around cars.

In addition to his love of music, Chris liked traveling, electronics, action movies, baseball, and having family and friends over for Sunday dinners. He enjoyed playing tennis, the arts, and attending live music performances and concerts. He was a patient man with a sharp memory, remembering every detail even through his final days.

He is preceded in death by his parents Rose and Humbert Trapani.

He is survived by his wife of over 37 years Delores, daughter Lauren and husband Collin, son Christopher Jr., stepson John, stepdaughter Jeneane and husband Richie, brother Robert, and grandsons Aiden, Camden, Richie, Andrew, and Jacob. His sense of humor, calming demeanor, and the sounds of him playing the piano will be deeply missed.

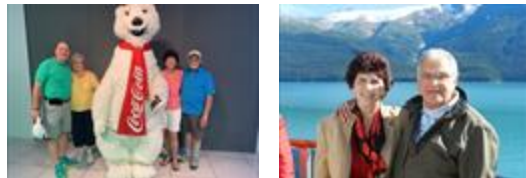
