*Sylvia: Mom loved the Casino. While she lived in New York, on many occasions we went to Atlantic City via excursion bus. On one particular occasion, I went with her and upon returning on the bus, everyone asked her if she won. Her response was, so so (meaning she won some money). Then they would ask her, how about your daughter. Her response was, she played \$20.00, but did not win, so she sat and read a book.

*Timothy: Mom never saw me play soccer/football in Trinidad, but was responsible for washing and ironing my soccer uniform. The jersey was no problem but the pants (White) rain or sun we played in white pants. So after a

rainy day and muddy field the pants is muddy. She would say "look how they kick you up" all because the pants was muddy and needed to be placed in the "bleach" to get it white again For the next game later in the week.

Mom used to buy milk from a lady who delivered milk once a week. So mom did not want milk one day when the lady came. She told Harry to say mom is not home. Harry said to the lady "mom said to say she is not home" mom had to buy milk that day.

When I was about ten years old mom used to make coffee every morning and serve me a small cup to wake me up.

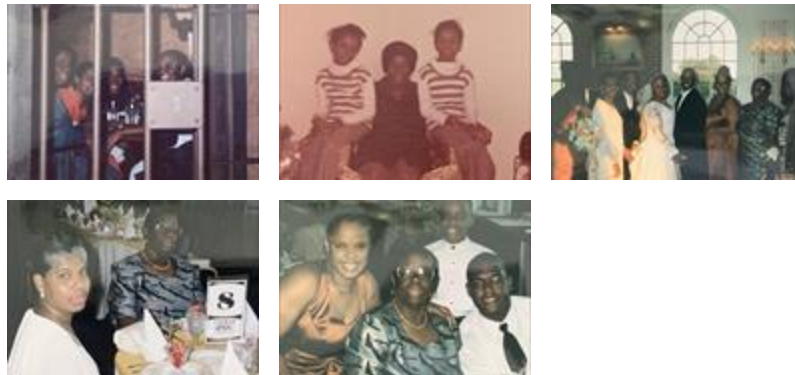

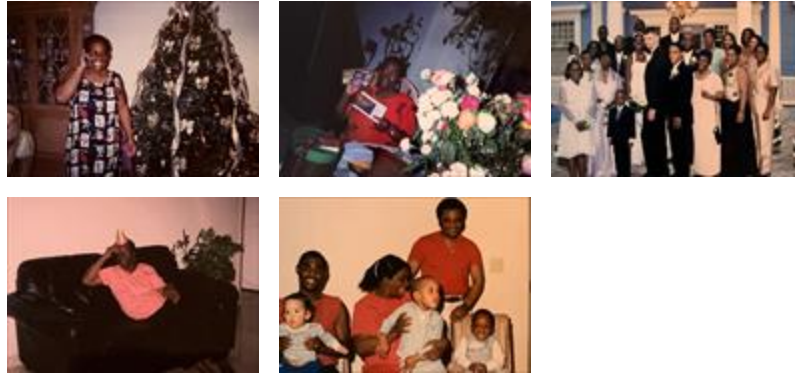

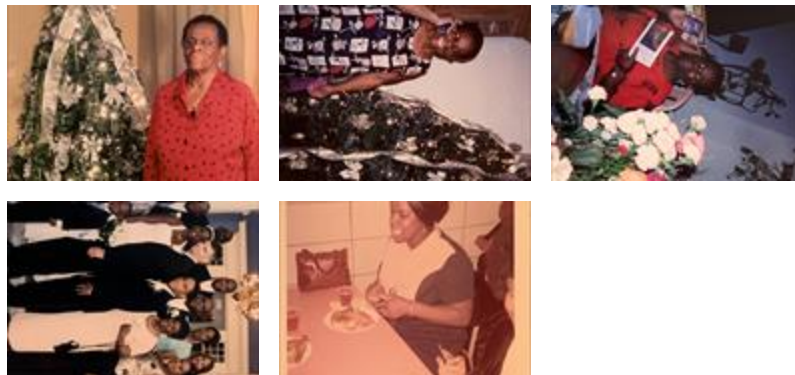
