Tim, the middle child of Floyd and Earline Hicks was born on October 1, 1963 in East St. Louis, Illinois. He graduated from Nashville Community High School in 1981. He graduated from Harding University with a Bachelor of Arts in Bible, a Master of Science in Education with an emphasis in religious education, and a minor in Business Management.

Tim married Rebecca Taylor on July 20, 1985. Their life adventure was blessed with two sons, Timothy Ryan and Benjamin Taylor. Tim loved camping, hiking, playing games, and hanging out with family. He loved his family with every part of himself. He was a loving father and devoted husband. Working with teens, children, and their families was Tim's passion. He loved directing Bible Camp, Retreats, Mission trips, Vacation Bible Schools, and other activities that brought spiritual growth and joy to the kids he worked with.

Tim's passion for serving children in the community was apparent in his volunteering as Den Leader and Cub Master for both of his son's groups. While living in Tyler, he also started a mentoring program at an elementary
