Gerald (Jerry) Eugene Talkington, 88, died on November 29, 2015 in Spring, Texas. Jerry was born in Ashtabula, Ohio on April 11, 1927. He was the younger of two boys. After a tour of duty in Germany near the end of WWII, Jerry returned to the States to attend Wooster College in Ohio. While attending Wooster he earned his bachelor of science in geology. In 1952 while attending Wooster College, Jerry met and married Margaret Curry. They remained married until his death.

Fresh out of school he went to work for Gulf Oil Corp in Pittsburgh, PA. This is just one of many cities where Gulf took them during his career. After 30 plus years working for Gulf he and Marge retired in Houston, Texas before moving to their lake house in Louisiana.

Jerry was the father of two boys and simply “Mr. T” or “Mr. Jerry” or Granddad to many more. Jerry and Marge lived in Louisiana on Lake Toledo Bend for 18 years. They were known for having an open door, food on the table, and gas in the boats. Family and friends have fond memories of laughing, eating, swimming, fishing and skiing at Granny and Granddad’s house. In 2004 they returned to the Houston area.

Jerry is preceded in death by his parents, Ross and Marguerite, and his brother Robert. He is survived by his wife of 63 years Margaret Talkington; sons, David Talkington and wife Sabra, Greg Talkington and wife Kim;
