



## Glenn Allen Hardy

December 22, 1940 - March 13, 2020

Glenn Allen Hardy was born December 22, 1940 in St. Louis Missouri. On Friday, March 13, 2020, Glenn passed away at the age of 79 after a long struggle with progressively debilitating neurological disorders. Glenn has called Spring, Texas his home for the past 43 years.

The only child of William and Viola Hardy, Glenn grew up in St. Louis Missouri where he attended Normandy High School. He earned a Bachelors degree from University of Missouri in Columbia and a Masters in Business Administration from Washington University in St. Louis. On July 16, 1966 he married Jeanne Treffts. Glenn's work as an accountant took him to New Brunswick, New Jersey; Atlanta, Georgia; and finally Spring, Texas in 1977. Glenn and Jeanne's two children, Melissa and Matthew were born in Atlanta in the early seventies. In 1980, Glenn and his family joined the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints of which Glenn was a faithful member throughout the rest of his life. In the early eighties, Glenn left accounting to pursue a new career as a commercial real estate broker. Glenn had a variety of skills including gardening, car mechanics and carpentry making him a very handy man to have around the house. Glenn had a love of animals - among his pets were rabbits, chickens, dogs, horses and a cow.

Glenn is preceded in death by his parents, William Allen Hardy and Viola Louise Kramer of St. Louis, MO. Glenn is survived by his wife of 53 years

Jeanne Louise Hardy, his children Melissa (Greg) Kam and Matthew Hardy and his grandchildren Parker, Lauren and Jackson.
