



## Jeffrey Anderson

Jeff Anderson, 61, of Spring, Texas, formerly of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Tuesday, July 19, 2022. Jeff was born on October 14, 1960, in Boone, Iowa. At a young age his family moved to Cedar Rapids, Iowa where Jeff attended Coolidge Elementary, Taft Junior High, and Jefferson High School, graduating in 1979. Jeff attended Northeast Missouri State University and Iowa State University.

Jeff spent 38 years working in the environmental field. He began as an Environmental Specialist for TxDOT before becoming an environmental consultant. He worked for Quadrant Consultants, Carter and Burgess and Jacobs Engineering before joining Klotz Associates. Jeff has been with RPS Group for over 10 years. He is recognized as one of the foremost experts in environmental studies. Jeff was also an outstanding teacher and mentor.

Jeff was actively involved with the North Houston Association for over 16 years and served as a Board member for over 13 years. He served as Environmental Committee Chair for many of those years, and then served as Board Liaison for that committee. Jeff was recently awarded with the Association's Compass Award for his countless contributions.

Jeff was an avid pool player in his spare time. He also enjoyed his family vacations, especially to Colorado where he always searched out activities like skiing, white water rafting, backpacking and snowmobiling. Jeff also enjoyed a good ride on his motorcycle.

Jeff is survived by his twin daughters, Kayla and Morgan Anderson; mother

Arliss Anderson; brother Jerry Anderson, and wife Tricia; bother John Anderson and wife Tammy; nephews Eric, Troy and Sam Anderson. He was preceded in death by his father Thomas Anderson.
