Johanna Pesl passed away peacefully on March 10, 2026, in her home in Spring, Texas at the age of 90. She was born on November 18, 1935, in Weimar Texas to Emil and Willie Jo Neiser.

She is survived by her husband, Joseph J. Pesl and celebrated 65 years of marriage together. They have 6 children: Stephanie Love, Carl (Janet) Pesl, Martin (Becky) Pesl, Michelle (Brian) Johnson, Christopher Pesl, and Andrea (Michael) Stakes. Her family grew over the years with 16 grandchildren and 32 great-grandchildren.

Johanna was also survived by her brother William Neiser, sister-in-law Virginia Neiser and brother-in-law Edwin Jo Peters.

Together they built a loving family and raised six children: Stephanie, Carl, Marty, Michelle, Chris and Andi. They also dedicated one hour of Perpetual Adoration weekly for over 30 years at St. Thomas More Catholic Church in Houston. Johanna enjoyed many hobbies throughout her life. She loved cooking, crocheting, ceramics, sewing and later making rosaries, continuing the tradition of her father and mother after they no longer could. She also had a deep appreciation for flowers, plants, birds and animals. Above all else, Johanna cherished time with her family. Her grandchildren and great-grandchildren brought her tremendous joy, especially in her later years along with extended family who will all remember her for her kindness, faith, and devotion to family.
