John Alfred (Jack) Young, 72, passed away at his home in Menard, Texas, on December 3, 2010. Born in Cleveland, Ohio on January 31, 1938, he graduated with honors from Kirtland High School in Kirtland, Ohio, where he was a member of the National Honor Society and the Lake County Scholarship Club. He was awarded a football scholarship to Case Institute of Technology in Cleveland where he graduated in mechanical engineering in 1963. He was a member of Phi Delta Theta Fraternity. He attended graduate school at the University of California in Long Beach, and was employed there by North American Aviation before entering the the U.S. Army, where he attained the rank of Private First Class, with service in the U.S. and Alaska.

Jack was a merchant marine with a fresh water captain license and a first mate license in saltwater. Being a member of the Maritime Seafarer's Union, he sailed as a First Mate officer on ships that traveled around the world, to ports such as Japan, Hawaii, Iraq, China, Hong Kong, France, England and Portugal.

He is a copyrighted author of "The Religious Order," a complete Bible study, and has had an article published in a mariner's magazine. He was an accomplished musician on the piano, banjo, and guitar. He had played in Jamboree London Hall in Londaon, Texas and at Luchenbach, Texas. He raised and bred AKC beagles.

He was a long time member of Mensa and Intertel, an international high IQ society.

He is loved and much admired by his survivors: brother, Robert E. Young (Patricia), Sisters, Patricia A. Christenson (Richard), Mary Lou Peters (Jeffrey), aunts, Rosemary Puening and Margaret Coombes; nieces and nephews: Rick Christenson, Laura Gollehon, Robert Young, Janet Jacobson, Darren Young, (of whom he was especially fond), Pamela Jacobs, Vicki Barski, Diana Kopp, Stephen Young, Ricky Cheek, Tammy Cheek and Terry Cheek.
