Judy Medearis Fleetwood-Propst was born on December 30, 1946, in Pasadena, TX, and passed away on November 27, 2024, in The Woodlands, TX. Judy faced her diagnosis of dementia with remarkable courage and resilience. Judy graduated from Pasadena High School in 1965 and most of her career consisted of positions as Senior and Executive Administrative Assistant in the Energy and Healthcare sectors. In her later years, Judy rescued a standard poodle named Pearl, and together they trained to become a pet therapy team and visited terminally ill patients at Memorial Herman in The Woodlands. Judy was known for her great sense of humor, loving nature, willingness to help others and her fabulous sense of style. In her teenage years she was a barrel racer with the SRA rodeo circuit and her love for the rodeo continued as she volunteered for the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, on the Conroe-Metro Committee, and achieved lifetime membership. Judy also volunteered at the Montgomery County Fair on the non-junior livestock committee. She served on both committees for the last 25 years. Judy's passions included baseball, especially as a devoted fan of the Houston Astros, Mexican food and margaritas, crafts, sewing, and spending time with her 5 o'clock Flock.

Judy is survived by her devoted husband of 20 years, Jim Propst; her loving daughter, Monica Zwahr-Stewart; grandson, Carson B. Stewart; and brother, Alfred "Jimmy" Medearis. Judy was preceded in death by her parents, Alfred

J. and Maxine Medearis, and several beloved pets including Pearl, Marley, Maggie and Gunter. She leaves behind a legacy of love, laughter and cherished memories that will live on in the hearts of her family and friends.
