“ Here is what I had prepared to share at the service:

I first met Keri when she was a student in my dual credit history class at North Haris College. Even in the dual credit environment that tends to attract bright students, I was struck by Keri's intellectual curiosity. She participated easily when I initiated discussions and her gift for writing made her an especially rewarding student to teach.

Keri was interested not only in history, but also in current events. And she shared my passion for all things French. As a result, she reached out to me after her graduation and I was honored to be a resource to her as she found her way through the world. When she moved to Santa Fe, New Mexico, I introduced her to some of my people so she had a foundation to start from. And as she traveled the world, I made sure she was plugged into my network so she always had someone to turn to.

Keri and I had an especially vibrant relationship when she joined my team at Global Peace Initiative in 2005. I was in charge of public relations and she was a hard-working, curious, and impossibly good-humored colleague. Keri was indispensable as we planned a diplomatic-level tour for our principal to meet with the heads of state of Libya and Syria. She and I worked closely together in attempting to contact North Korean strongman Kim-Jong Il. We couldn't simply call the embassy; we had to get creative. And ultimately, we spoke with the North Korean ambassador to Switzerland. We laughed for years about those calls made from our personal mobile phones led to the certainty of us having files with assorted intelligence communities.

More recently, Keri joined a discussion group I am a part of on Facebook. After a seemingly endless string of sentences in FB jail, she told me she was permanently banned—and she reemerged as Keri Antsinmyeyes. She played such an important role in that community. She shared a younger voice and perspective. She railed against the establishment and constantly called out boomers for being...well, boomers.

Keri never hesitated to speak truth to power and to hold people

accountable for their words and their actions. She explained the dark web and nuances of information technology to people who questioned how things work. She was so generous with her knowledge. In recent years I am sure that I learned more from Keri than she ever learned from me. I will miss her.

You did not want to turn back. Remember when you and I took the Ute Trail down from Trail Ridge Road to Upper Beaver Meadows? Remember Daddy Daughter nights? And the time you and I went to the zoo, just the two of us? Love those pictures from then. Remember going down into the Molly Kathleen Gold Mine in Colorado? The Indian Princesses campouts? Do you remember the time I played Santa for TNW parade? I sat at the clubhouse and kids told me what they wanted. You knew it was me. You were very observant. You noticed that 'Santa' had the same shoes on as I did that day. Do you remember shooting IDPA with me? I have a couple of videos of those shoots that I watch sometimes.

*I love the way you react to Liam and Remy in the photos. They are so cute and are such an extension of you. I am looking forward to watching them grow to fine, young men. Mom and I will miss you so very much. We know that you loved us and can see it in so many photos. I will miss the conversations we had so often. I will miss watching *The Fifth Element* together, and *Spirited Away*. I will miss the meals we had together, the swapping of texts keeping in touch while Mom and I are on trips, and sending pics of spiders and other things we see in our day to day lives.*

Though you have passed, you will remain in my mind and in my heart. I will never forget you.
