



## Lawrence "Larry" Foussadier

December 8, 1966 - February 10, 2025

Lawrence "Larry" Antoine Foussadier, 58, of Conroe, Texas, a caring and compassionate husband, brother, and uncle who lived a life of devotion to his many friends and family, passed away on February 10, 2025. He was born on December 8, 1966 in The Bronx, New York to Esther and Jean Foussadier. He was the youngest of four children, after his sister Mary Ann, and brothers Victor and Gene. Larry spent his childhood growing up in The Bronx and later moved to Texas where he graduated from Klein Oak High School in 1985.
