Beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, Loreto Giovannangelo, better known as Gio, age 82, passed away peacefully on February 1, 2025. Born on January 16, 1943 to Grace and Loreto Giovannangelo of Schenectady, NY, he lived a life full of love, dedication, and adventure. Gio attended Mt. Pleasant High School, where he met the love of his life, before serving his country in the U.S. Air Force for four years, stationed at Dover, Delaware as an Airborne Radio Radar Technician with MATS.
