



Maria (Neide) José Barbosa Huseth

October 5, 1979 - June 1, 2025

Neide, a force of nature, a beacon of strength, and the heart of every gathering, passed away June 1, 2025 at the age of 45 on the fifth anniversary of the death of her son Hayden. She was tenacious in everything she pursued, bringing passion and perseverance to every challenge she faced. A devoted mother and devout Catholic, she poured love, wisdom, and joy into her family, shaping lives with her boundless care.

She was the life of every party, the one who brought laughter and energy to those around her. Social and warm, she made friends everywhere regardless of background, always uplifting others with her kindness and generosity.

Whether she was helping someone in need or chasing the pavement as a dedicated runner, she lived life with purpose and heart.

Her impact will be felt forever by the family and friends who loved her dearly. Though she is no longer with us, her spirit—strong, fun, and full of life—will live on in the memories and the love she shared.

Neide was born in Pernambuco Brazil and lived in Texas the last 13 years.
