



Marjorie Ann Walsh

August 8, 1939 - February 27, 2024

Marjorie (Marge) Ann Robert Walsh passed away, surrounded by her children, on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, in Houston, Texas. Although she was 84 years old and had recently been admitted to the hospital for health complications, her passing was fairly quick and unexpected.

Marjorie made her grand entrance into this world on August 8, 1939 in St. Paul, Minnesota, the eldest of four children born to Margaret (nee-Eckert) and Henry Robert. Her parents and two of her younger brothers - Ronald and Gregory - passed before her.

She is survived by a younger brother, Christopher (Beverly), and her four children, Stephen (Laura), Gerald, Kathleen (Kenneth), and Margaret, whom she affectionately called Steve, Jerry, Kathy, and Peggy. Also, seven grandchildren: Christopher, Emily (Logan), Ricky, Sara (Tristan), Ashley, Alexis, and Wesley; and one great-granddaughter, Riley Rose.

Marge led an admirable life, always giving to others while also having lots of time for her own adventures. After earning her degree in Chemistry, Marge worked as a beer taster at Hamm's brewery in St. Paul, despite not even liking beer. She soon transferred to a brewery in Houston but then was able to stay home to raise her four children. When her youngest was five, Marge went to work as a chemist at Exxon (later Nalco/Exxon), where she would spend the

rest of her career and eventually retire, having acquired oil spill patents along the way. Her home in Houston was always open to her family and friends for visits, vacations, and holidays, and she was very generous to her children and grandchildren.

Marge was a member of many groups, several of which she served as president, including the Greenwood Forest Women's Club and Nalco/Exxon Retirees. Marge volunteered for NAM, among other organizations, and enjoyed helping seniors with their taxes.

When she wasn't spending time with family and friends or volunteering, Marge traveled extensively. Her favorite destinations included the Galapagos Islands, Alaska, and Italy. She also organized trips to Branson, Dollywood, Mackinac Island, and many other destinations. Marge had a witty sense of humor and loved to laugh. She played bridge with her friends and enjoyed a spirited game of solitaire with her family. Marge was fond of game shows, court shows, gymnastics and ice skating. Marge's patio and yard were filled with her favorite plants and trees, which attracted the birds she loved to watch.

Marge was loved by all who knew her and she will be greatly missed.

Red roses were her favorite. Next time you see one, enjoy the beauty, drink in the melodious scent and think of Marge.

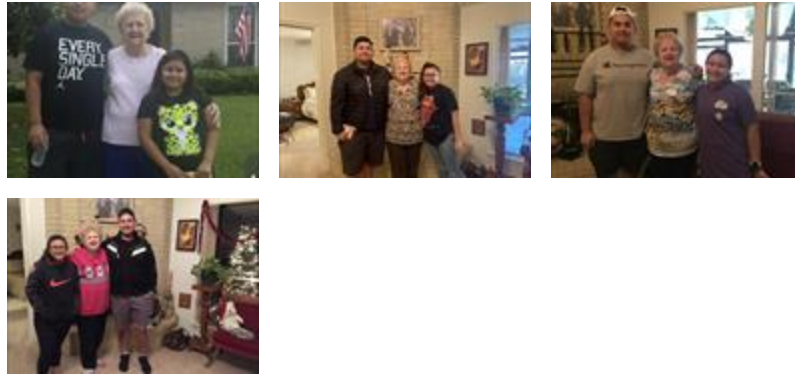

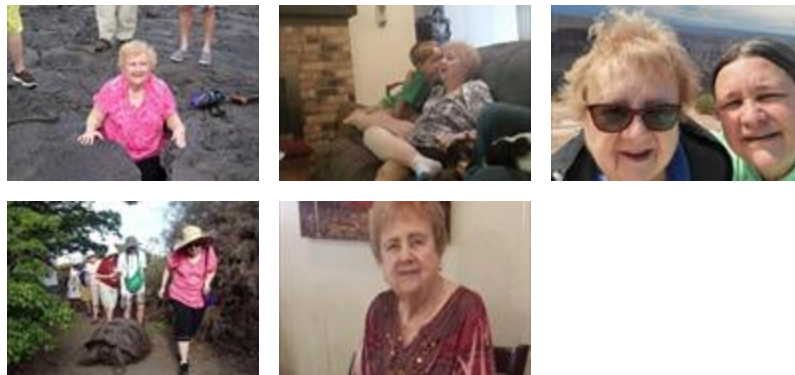
