Mark Stephen Wolf, 55, died of pancreatic cancer on September 24, 2011 at Odyssey Hospice, Houston, Texas. He was born to Julia D. Wolf & Willie Earl Wolf on November 8, 1955 in San Antonio.

Mark graduated in 1974 from Thomas Jefferson High School in San Antonio, Texas. He continued his education and became an iron worker in San Antonio local union 66, where he was promoted to Superintendent in 1995. He was instrumental in the construction of many buildings that stand as a lasting tribute of his contribution to the skylines of both San Antonio and Houston.
