



Marvin Delano Moran Sr.

April 3, 1935 - May 27, 2025

Marvin D. Moran, Sr, known to his family as “Grandpa,” went to be with his LORD and Savior on Tuesday, the 27th of May 2025. He was 90, living in Spring, Texas. He was born April 3, 1935, in Tampa, Florida to Marvin Marcus Moran and Mabel McInnis Moran.

Marvin grew up in a large family in a rural part of Hillsborough County, Florida. He graduated from Hillsborough High School in 1953 and went on to graduate from the University of Alabama in 1958. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering.

Marvin went to work for the Florida State Road Department (currently Florida Department of Transportation – FDOT) straight out of college and he worked there for thirty years. After his early retirement, he traveled for a while and then eagerly returned to the work force as a City Engineer for the City of Tallahassee, where he worked for another twenty years.

Later in life, Marvin would look back on his life and reflect on the four T’s of his life. The first T stood for Tampa, Florida where he was born and raised. The second T stood for Tuscaloosa, Alabama where he attended the University of Alabama. It was during this time at college that he met his first wife Boni, the mother of his three children. The third T stood for Tallahassee, Florida where he worked and raised his three children. The fourth T stood for Texas where

he lived out the last ten years of his life.

The number one priority of his life was his personal relationship with Jesus Christ, his LORD and Savior. He taught a Men's Bible Study class at Immanuel Baptist Church in Tallahassee, Florida for many years. He also volunteered and traveled with the Bill Glass Prison Ministry sharing the gospel message about Jesus to numerous inmates.

Marvin is survived by his three children: Marvin Moran, Jr, Sharon Moran and Rob Moran; He will be dearly missed as well by his two lovely daughters-in-law: Jann Moran and Deborah Moran. Marvin also had four wonderful grandchildren and their spouses: Joshua and Miranda Moran, Elizabeth and Jonathan Craig, Bailey and Brendan Parsons, and Raven Moran, and additionally he was blessed with five loving great grandchildren: Charlotte Craig, Jackson Craig, Savannah Craig, Carson Craig and Kane Moran
