Mayrene Jean (Dossman) McDaniel, went to be with her heavenly Father on October 23, 2022, at the age of 81, where she has now been joyously reunited with her parents August and Hilda Dossman, her brother Kenneth Dossman, and twin sister Lorene (Dossman) Denby.

At first, Mayrene said "no way" to Ted but eventually fell in love, and Lorene and Mayrene had a beautiful double wedding at Salem Lutheran Church in 1962. Mayrene and Ted started their family living in Tomball, Texas where their children Kevin and Kendra were born, and then moved to Galena Park, Texas.

A couple of years later, after learning they would have a third child Karmen,

they traveled back to Tomball, Texas as they wanted their beloved family doctor, Dr. Graham to deliver. Mayrene always had in her heart to move back to her hometown and eventually, she and Ted found their way back to the Tomball/Rosehill area in 1977.

Mayrene did secretarial work for oil and gas companies early on in her career but later took some time off to raise her three children, cheering them on at all their events. Later on, she made her way back into the workforce and even worked for Ted at his insurance business for many years before they both retired.

Her faith in God and unconditional love for family and friends always shined through her sweet personality daily. If the church doors were open, you could bet she would be there. Mayrene served in various ministries at Salem Lutheran Church singing in the choir, serving on the altar guild and on the historical archive committee as she was part of the multi-generational members of the church.
