“ Tia, you have and always will be one of my favorite Tia's. You taught me how to be tough because I was getting bullied in school and taught me to never let myself from anyone.

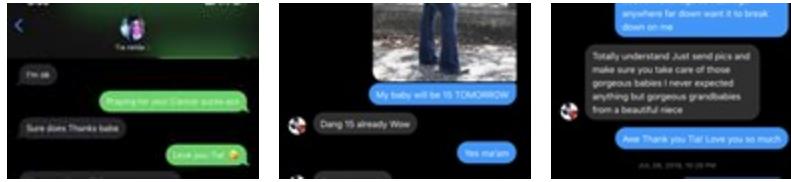
