Nicole Marie Schumacher, age 35, of Tomball, Texas, passed away unexpectedly on March 12, 2023 due to injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident. She graduated in 2006 from Berlin High School.

Nicole was a diligent and dedicated employee. Her drive and determination to succeed propelled her forward in every opportunity she took on. Because of her big and energetic personality, you never missed her being in the room.
