Died January 8, 2015, in Houston. Born Feb 9, 1932, in Homewood Mississippi to schoolteachers Robert Lee Noel and Pattie Mae Guyse. After a short time in New Orleans, the family moved to Galveston in 1942. Pat graduated from Ball High School in 1949, and the University of Texas in 1955. He served his country well, starting in high school as a member of the JROTC rifle team; continued in ROTC at UT, serving full time in the Army during the Korean War era in the Armored Cavalry division at Camps Hood, Chaffee, and Sill. He began work at an early age at the soda fountain of a corner drugstore in Galveston. He went on to become a highly successful broker in the securities business, a top producer at Paine Webber. He later worked as a real estate agent. Among Pat's many strengths, he, like his father, knew how to talk with people. He enjoyed helping people find their dream homes. He married Cecelia Elizabeth Miller in 1955, and they have enjoyed 59 years of marriage. Carrying on his legacy are his sons: Martin (son Tristan (wife Kendra), daughter Megan); James (wife Kathy, sons Christopher (and wife Sara) and David; Richard (wife Kathy Broussard, daughter Claire). Other survivors include sister Jane Witt (husband Bill, son Mark (wife Jana, son Justin (wife Laura Lea), daughter Courtney); Nephews Robert Noel (wife Gail, daughters Monique, Robin, Mary Louise), Thomas Leon Noel, and niece Yvonne Mayes. Also brothers-in-law Robert Miller, John Miller (wife Mary), Prince Miller, Thomas Miller; sisters-in-law Mary Jane Patterson (husband John), Nancy Blaschke (husband Leonard), and many other extended family.

Predeceased by his parents; brothers Charles Ray, Robert William (& wife Louise), Thomas Leon (& wife Hilda); sister Thelma Louise; daughter-in-law Laurie; nephew Mike Witt, & other extended family. A firm believer in Jesus Christ, he grew up in the Baptist tradition and later converted to Catholicism.
