Phillip Terry Sisk went to be with the Lord on Monday, November 28th, 2022 less than a week away from his 80th birthday. He will be reunited with his parents Cecil W. Sisk and Lolly Sisk Dorries, along with his brother Michael L. Sisk.

Other than a short time in the Fingerprinting Department of Beaumont Police

Department, his employment was generally in the bookkeeping area. His attention to detail allowed him to not only enjoy, but be great at his job. Later he realized another passion of his; to sing. Every Sunday at Greenbriar Baptist Church near his home in Houston, he would sing a solo or two for the congregation.

Terry was a proud man whose pride extended not only to his Mom and Dad, but to his daughter, son-in law, his grandchildren, brother and sisters, nieces and aunts, uncles and cousins.

Terry will be remembered for many things. Among them was his incredible sense of humor ,a heart warming smile, and remarkable ability to make friends out of strangers.
