### The Life of Randy Rae Eudy

The LORD Jesus took Randy Rae Eudy by the hand and led him out of this earthly life straight into the Kingdom of God early Sunday morning, July 2, 2023 to his mansion with that infamous white picket fence.

Randy was born August 26, 1976 in Kermit, Texas to Rickey Joe Eudy and Virginia Ruth Carlisle Eudy.

While visiting his great-grandparents, Rev. Harvey & Agnes Williams, with his brother, Seth Allan Eudy and mother Ruthie, Ruthie asked Dad Williams, a minister, to take a chapter out of Elijah and Elisha's story and bless Randy and Seth with a double-portion of Dad's anointing. A bit surprised, but pleased, Dad gathered up the boys and his Bible and prayed that God would bless them with a double-portion of his anointing. Years later the boys were baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit at Bro. John Osteen's Lakewood Church in Houston, TX.

Growing up, the boys spent endless hours camping, fishing and exploring and continued that passion of love for the outdoors with trips including their cousins, Josh & Joel Sauber and Shelley Fletcher. The five could come up with the most outlandish camps, forts, mazes, treehouses and platforms they built to support their camping tents.

Due to Randy's high grades by the time he graduated school in Mt. Belvieu, TX, he was invited to the Navy Nuclear School, however another government agency, the US Postal Service scooped him up and he was employed there for 13 years.

During that time, feeling a ministry call on his life, Randy was ordained as a minister. Although he didn't pursue this calling, it was always in the back of his heart. He knew Bible scriptures from front to cover and would recall verses for whatever your need might be to help you out of any situation and turn things around in your life. The first couple of hours of every morning were filled with biblical preaching while he got ready for work or the day ahead. Recently he enrolled in Leadership ministry courses with a local church hoping to fulfill that ministry calling.

Life events happened and his interests went another direction. Wanting to get into the quality assurance vocation, and with the assistance and encouragement of his step-father Anthony J. Weick (Jay), a Quality Assurance Manager, he introduced Randy and Seth to Quality Assurance Inspection Engineering College Courses. Both graduated and Randy followed this line of work for several years, and so did Seth.

After the energy industry began to wane, Randy's interest turned to Optometry and he took courses to obtain his certification and again, aced every test. This was his current profession.

Randy loved God, Jesus and his family more than anything but he was also a fierce defender & protector if you touched one. Yet there was an onery, playful side of Randy...a great sense of humor...anything to make you laugh... anything for attention...especially from the ladies.

Randy was always a kind, very tender-hearted, generous - almost to a fault

person. He mentioned many times of a desire to open what he called a 'soup kitchen' showing his love to tend to the needs of people.

Grilling was his favorite pastime. Randy would cook a brisket on the pit all night long, setting an alarm to go turn & baste the meat hoping that everyone raved over the tenderness & taste. And when crawfish were in season, Randy was in charge of the boiler and would cook mudbugs all afternoon until everyone had their fill.

But the joy to his mother, Ruthie, was being taught to dance by her son, and his step-sister Toni Weick how to two-step. Those were fun times.

Randy's precious moment of life will be forever cherished in the lives of his family and friends. He is survived by his parents: Ruthie and Jay Weick; Rick Eudy and wife Judy; his brother Seth Eudy and wife Haylee and daughters Chloe and Katelyn; his sons Cade Jacob Eudy, Cameron Todd Tucker and granddaughter Zoe; half-sister Tammy Gay Nunn and many other family members and friends.

Randy was preceded in death by his half-brother Rickey Lynn Nunn.

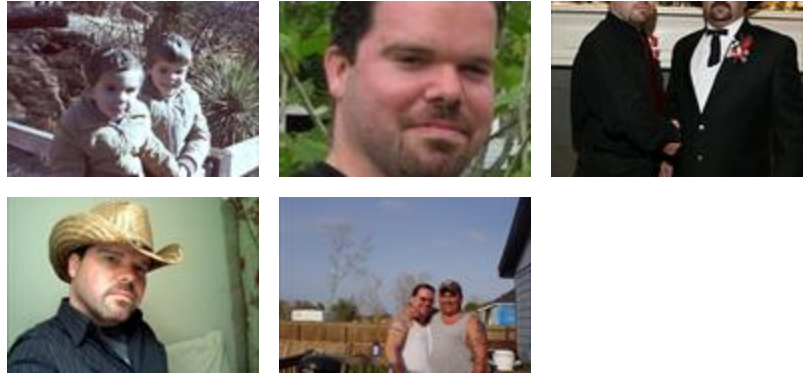

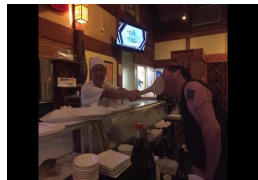
