On February 4, 2019 Richard (Ricky) Watts, beloved Son, Brother, Husband, Father and Friend, went home to be with our Lord at the age of 59.

Ricky was born in Atlanta, GA, October 14, 1959, and grew up in the surrounding area. In 1972, at the age of 13, he achieved the rank of Eagle Scout.
