Dr. Robert (Bob) Wayne Klemm, 77, left this world and entered his eternal home in the early morning hours of March 29, 2025. Dr. Bob was born in 1947 in Hammond, Indiana to Walter Robert and Phyllis Harwood Klemm. He graduated from Hammond High School in 1967.

He accepted Christ as his personal savior at Hessville Christian Church in Hessville, Indiana at age 9 and lived the rest of his life trying to be faithful until the end.

Bob attended Lincoln Christian College in Lincoln, Illinois where he met and married Casandra Lee McKenzie (Big Stone Gap, Virginia) in 1967. They just celebrated 58 years together.

Bob was a Vietnam Veteran serving in the US Air Force and the US Army. Dr. Bob earned his doctorate from Southern Illinois University (Carbondale, Illinois) in statistics and adult learning with minors in psychology and history. His wife, Sandy, earned her Ph. T – putting hubby through at the same time. Dr. Bob was a dedicated teacher, especially Bible. He taught Bible (not books) and loved the word. Because of many moves (military and career) he was blessed to teach in many churches. His teaching touched the lives of students

of every age – young to the older than himself. People all over the world will be sharing his “Bobisms” he shared in his classes for many years. Bob was privileged to teach in Croatia, Serbia and especially at Bethshean Mission in Mexico.
