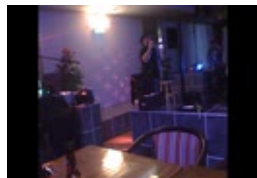

With a broken heart and tears in my eyes I have to say goodbye although everyday I will cry because it's hard to say goodbye just know your memory will never go away.

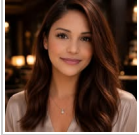
