He never said no to his family and friends. If you needed someone to take care of your dog, wanted to go on a last minute hunting trip or required a late night wingman, Sean was your man.

If he loved you, he let you know it. When Sean entered a room the lights seemed to brighten. A goofy grin on a cocked head and arms spread wide ready for a great bear hug. Sean was deeply loved and will be dearly missed.

He is survived by his mother Patsy Roman, father Mark Sensat, step-parents Darlene Jensen and Jules Roman and brothers Heath, Jason, Scott, Vic, Greg and Kenny.
