Shirley Gail Hyman was born on June 6, 1951, in Dallas, TX and died on October 11, 2024 at the age of 73 in Houston, TX following a two-and-a-half-year battle with pancreatic cancer.

In 1970, while at a party, Shirley introduced herself to a handsome pilot named Ken Hyman. To get his attention, she asked him if he could teach her how to tie his necktie. Six months later, she married that man who remained the love of her life until the day she died. Shirley and Ken were just shy of celebrating 54 years of marriage.

Shirley spent her life bringing light to everyone she met. We always said that she never met a stranger. Positivity always radiated from her, and when she faced any difficult or negative situation, she would simply say, "It could always

be worse.” She truly understood having the right perspective. Even in death, the worst would be suffering. To that end, we are grateful she is no longer in pain.

Shirley loved to dance and play games, especially line-dancing and playing Bunko with her friends. She was a generous woman who volunteered for multiple organizations, including the Commemorative Air Force where she traveled with her husband touring the country with the Texas Raiders B-17. She was a devoted mother who always supported her daughters, and a proud grandmother who adored her talented grandson.

Shirley is survived by her husband, Kenneth Hyman; her daughters Shelby and Leslie Hyman; bonus daughter, Vanessa Campbell; brothers, Richard and Daryl Milligan; sister-in-law, Valrena Butcher; and grandson Preston Hatem.

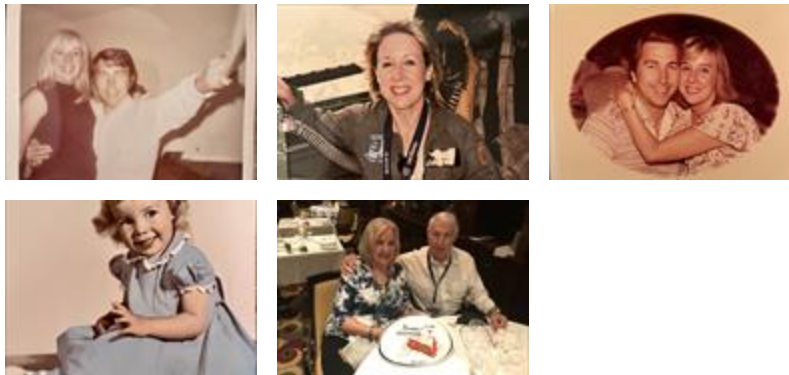
