It is with profound sadness that Steve's family announces his passing on June 4th at the age of 72 in Houston, Texas.

Steve was born in Chanute Kansas to Gene & Helen Nelson on December 22nd 1951. Steve grew up living in Joplin Missouri, Ottawa Kansas and Alva Oklahoma.

It would be difficult to chronicle all of Steve's adventures through his 40 plus year career in the oil & gas industry. He spent time in over 50 countries and made it to 6 of the 7 continents. He lived and worked in places such as Guatemala, Mexico, Venezuela, Brazil, India, France, The United Kingdom, Kuwait, South Korea, Nigeria, Oklahoma, Kansas and Texas to name a few.
