Susie Virginia Gallagher unexpectedly passed away on September 10, 2019 in Tomball, Texas at the age of 64. Susie was a long-time resident of Vienna, VA before relocating to Houston, TX. She was a devoted mother to Emilia and Ginny, phenomenal grandmother to Olivia, Easton, and Malcolm, and loving friend to many. In 2016, she retired from Exxon Mobil. She was an avid sports fan, a talented AAU swimmer and proud Penn State alumni. Her enthusiasm for her girls was unmatched.
