Terry Craig McKissick, 81, of Woodville, Texas passed away Thursday, October 24, 2013. He was born October 7, 1932 in Grimes, Iowa to Cedric & Marguerite McKissick. Terry is preceded in death by his parents; wife, Himelda McKissick; and son, Michael McKissick.
