### Victor Cabungcal: A Legacy of Integrity and Love

It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of a remarkable man, Victor Cabungcal. Victor passed away peacefully in Spring, Texas, on Friday, November 14, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. He was 86 years old.

Victor was born in Batangas, Philippines, on July 28, 1939, to the late Arscenia Macasaet and Hilarion Cabungcal. His life was a testament to love, hard work, and unwavering devotion to his family.

### Life and Career

Victor's life was characterized by an exceptional work ethic and quiet perseverance. A testament to his determination, he earned his way through college by working for Archbishop Alfredo Maria Obviar in Lucena, Philippines, serving as his housekeeper, cook, and acolyte for the many masses required in the Cathedral.

After earning his college credits, he worked at the University of Santo Tomas Hospital for twelve years in the Psychiatric Department. This education entitled him to take the Civil Service Police entrance exam, and he proudly served with the Manila Police Force for twelve years.

In 1983, Victor met his beloved Harriet and began a new life journey. After

relocating to the United States, he enrolled in a trade school to learn Tool and Die Machining. He had a successful career at the century-old E.J. Brooks in Newark, New Jersey. In 1988, he moved his family to Texas, where he once again adjusted to hospital life, working in the Operating Rooms of Memorial Hermann and St. Luke's Hospitals. His dedication earned him the respect of all who knew him, including the honor of being named "Employee of the Year" in 2007 by Memorial Hermann Health System, which was celebrated with a parade in The Woodlands and his portrait displayed proudly in the main entrance.

### Family and Devotion

Victor's true pride and joy was his family. He was the devoted husband of Harriet Cabungcal, and a loving, supportive father. He tirelessly attended countless sporting events, concerts, and extracurricular activities, always cheering on his children with quiet pride from the sidelines.

Victor was a pillar of support, selflessly raising the five children of his late brother as his own, providing them with support and education. He also consistently sent groceries and household items home monthly to his parents in the province.

Known for his quiet demeanor, Victor had a zany sense of humor and loved to tell a good joke, though his family will fondly remember his endearing habit of getting lost before reaching the punchline. A man of strong faith, his love was evident in every kind gesture, every moment of support, and every sacrifice he made for others.

### Survived By

Victor is survived by his caring wife, Harriet Cabungcal, and his seven children: Alicia, Juan, Victoria, Tor, Adrian, Andre, and Daniel. He is also survived by his twelve cherished grandchildren, his raised nieces and

nephews, and many extended family members and friends.

#### Predeceased By

Victor was preceded in death by his parents, Arscenia Macasaet and Hilarion Cabungcal, who passed away on the same night in 1983, and his brother.

#### Hobbies and Interests

Victor thoroughly enjoyed cruises and trips with his wife, Harriet, to Israel, Italy, The Netherlands, Spain, France, Croatia, Sicily, Monaco, Belgium, Mexico, and many islands in the Caribbean. He loved gardening and helping Harriet with her piano recitals and animal rescue efforts. He is also terribly missed by his black tuxedo cat, Blaise.
